An agreement for productions under £30m is currently in early discussion.

Art Department, Set Decoration, Graphics do not do Prep and Wrap, as per the PACT - BECTU MMP Agreement.

### ART DEPARTMENT 2025 - 2026 RATE CARD - FAQS

Before interpreting the rate guidance, please take some time to read the FAQs below.

#### What is the MINIMUM and 3+ YEAR MINIMUM?

#### MINIMUM

These are the base rates. No one should accept less than these rates. They are based on the minimum rates crew members have been paid in these roles over 2023-2024, adjusted for inflation.

#### 3+ YEAR MINIMUM:

These are guide rates for anyone who has established themselves in a role with at least 3 years of experience. Crew members should negotiate upwards of these rates according to their skill level and experience.

#### What are the working hours per day?

This depends which contract you are working under. For features over £30m, your contract will be based on the PACT-BECTU MMP agreement, in which the contracted hours are 11+1 (11 hours work and 1 hour for lunch) for off set crew.

For TV Drama Productions following the PACT - BECTU TV Drama Agreement, hours are 10+1. However, you could also be scheduled on a Semi-continuous working day (SCWD: 9.5 + 30) or a Continuous working day (CWD: 9) if agreed between your HoD and production.

Productions that do not follow either of these agreements are free to negotiate their own terms with crew members. Nevertheless, it is widely agreed that the Art Department is a self scheduling department and traditionally works 9+1 for the rates on the rate card.

#### **Box Rental**

We have provided a guide for minimum box rentals / allowances that crew should claim. This should be dependant on the value of your kit, and many members do claim higher rates. Please note that 'computer allowance' is for a basic laptop / desktop. If you have computer equipment of high value, you should claim 'Specialist Kit Rental' at a higher rate.

#### How have these rates been calculated?

In lieu of survey data, the 2025/2026 Rate Card changes are based on a 2.60% increase over the previous year; in line with the Construction Branch's annual inflation increase. Certain roles have had an additional increase up to 5.5% in order to protect parity between departments. Please see the parity chart in this rate card document

We would also like to highlight that inflation was 3.8% in the last 12 months and that crew should remind productions when negotiating that anything less than an 3.8% increase on your rate after a year, is a real time pay cut.

Yearly, the Bectu Art Department Branch holds a rates survey and collect results from approximately 1000 respondents. The new rates for each role are then carefully considered, across all bands, and also compared with the survey data.

A new Rates Survey will be issued in January 2026. With a possibility that the next Rate Card could be the start of ratification with Pact, this upcoming survey could be the most consequential in recent years. The quality of our survey data will be key to a favourable outcome, which would have ramifications for years to come

#### Are these rates ratified with PACT?

It is a long term goal of the Bectu Art Department Branch to have a rate card that is ratified with the Producers' Trade Association (PACT), along with the existing PACT - Bectu contract agreements.

In 2023, PACT and Bectu began discussions on agreed rate cards for several of the branches, including the ADs and Grips. However, these discussions were put on hold during the CMA investigation into production company rate fixing.

Now that the CMA investigation is finished, these discussions have resumed, and the Art Department Branch will endeavour to start its own negotiations for a ratified Rate Card as soon as possible.

#### What are the bands?

The bands that you see on the rate card are dictated by the Bectu - PACT TV and Film agreements. The film agreement is called the Major Motion Picture (MMP) Agreement and is for films with budgets over £30 million. There are currently no agreements for films under £30 million, however, the Bectu Art Department committee have identified 3 other commonly used terms used to refer to films of particularly budgets. Rates have been grouped into these bands: Motion Picture (5M-30M), Feature Film (1M - 5M) and Low Budget (<1M).

The Bectu-PACT TV agreement specifies 4 budget bands and these have been used on the rate card to group rates.

#### What about Holiday Pay?

These rates are inclusive of holiday pay at 12.07%. PAYE and Self employed crew members will be paid holiday pay at the end of the contract. Crew members who are LTD will not have holiday pay separated out.

The Bectu Art Department is currently questioning the legality of holiday pay being paid at the end of a contract.

## **ART DEPARTMENT 2025- 2026 BOX RENTAL & ALLOWANCES**



The chart below indicates which roles should charge for allowances.

Productions may attempt to cap some of these rates (ceasing payment after a number of weeks). Capping and allowances are negotiable and dependent on individual circumstances.

COMPUTER ALLOWANCE (Production Standard)	A fee paid to crew members who use their basic laptop / desktop for work-related tasks, compensating for equipment wear and tear. This rate will be set by the production and should be equal across departments. If you have computer equipment of high value, you should claim 'Specialist Kit Rental' at a higher rate.
PHONE ALLOWANCE	A fee paid to crew members, to cover the costs of using their personal phone for work requirement, including calls, data usage etc.
CAR ALLOWANCE	A fee paid to crew, to cover the costs associated with using a personal vehicle for work purposes. In addition to this fee, fuel receipts can also be claimed. Productions may negotiate on the percentage of receipts paid, to take into account fuel used for personal / commuting purposes.  If no car allowance is provided, mileage should be claimed at the HMRC rate (currently 45p per mile)
SOFTWARE ALLOWANCE	A payment for any specialist computer software or licences that you are required to provide for your role. EG. Vectorworks, Creative Suite etc.  Productions may pay this as monthly fee, calculated from the total cost of your software / subscriptions.
SPECIALIST KIT RENTAL	If you provide computer equipment of high value, you should claim this allowance rather than the standard computer allowance rate. This rate is negotiable and should be based on the value of your equipment list.

#### **Notes on Parity**

In 2020, the BECTU Art Committee created a responsibility chart which aligned roles with other roles that have comparable levels of responsibility on the **largest budget productions** This was to enable the committee to check rates across roles, and examine if certain roles were being under or over paid. Rates are being incrementally adjusted each year on the rate card to bring roles inline with their comparable roles, whilst still reflecting actual rates paid.

Roles were also aligned with roles from the construction department as a rate comparison exercise. It was discovered that the hourly rates for construction (who have a PACT ratified rate card) were much higher than the hourly rates of Art Department roles that have a similar level of responsibility.

For MMP, Art directors are on an median hourly rate of £45 for an 11 hour day (as contracted), or a £55 hour rate for a 9 hour day (as commonly worked)

By comparison, an HoD Carpenter (similar level of responsibility), gets £72.12 per hour for a 7.5 hour day.

In London design studios, freelance senior creative roles charge around £50 - £75 an hour.

#### Trainees:

Camera Trainees weekly rates are at £850 (10+1 TV) and £1020 (11+1 MMP)  $\,$ 

Grip Trainees range from £725 (Band 1 TV) to £1100 (MMP)

As a reminder, the current London Living Wage is £796/week for a 55 hours week; and National Living Wage (legally mandatory rate for anyone over 21) is £671.55/week for the same hours. No one should ever be offered less, for these hours, on any of the bands.

#### Set Decoration:

The Set Decorator has creative and budgetary responsibility for what appears on screen. Often working in partnership with the Production Designer to create the aesthetic through colour, texture and objects on screen. They are recognised alongside the designer for industry awards in design. Therefore, their role has been given parity with the Supervising Art Director.

In recent years the Set Decoration department and responsibilities for the team have grown immensely. Set Decoration crew often run large teams of internal and external manufacturers. It is no longer possible to use a few hire companies and retailers to source for the sets. It is not uncommon on the larger productions for Set Decoration to have their own art directors, concept artists, painters, modellers etc which were always traditionally only found within the Art Department. In 2020, a meeting was held with 163 Set Decoration crew members, where 93% voted that Set Decoration rates should have parity with Art Department rates as per the alignment of the roles on the Responsibility Diagram.

#### Graphics


Graphic roles have changed drastically over the last decade. It was agreed that Graphics Art Directors should now have pay parity with Art Directors. At the top level, Graphics Art Director is an HoD role, with responsibility for crewing the graphics department, controlling labour and spend budgets and managing and scheduling the graphics requirements for all departments and all the sets. The Graphics Art Director will often work directly under the Designer and also take responsibility for meetings and requests from producers and director. There is often little or no supervision from HoDs.
