Please save the date for the Nuvia Branch ADC, taking place on Saturday 6th February 2027. The running time will be approximately 09:45 to 15:30 (to be confirmed).

The ADC will take place at The Cliffs Hotel, Blackpool.

Our Branch has held an ADC ever since its inception without fail up to 2021, when unfortunately there was an hiatus following COVID-19, and further delays in following years due to events within the company and changes within the Branch.

Our revised Branch rules require us to hold either an ADC or AGM. Therefore, in compliance, we are reinstating the ADC from 2027 at 'The Cliffs', which has been the chosen venue for a number of decades, back to UKAEA/AEAT days.
