

Your future in retirement

If you're nearing retirement, you can still enjoy many of the services you value by becoming a retired member of Prospect. **To qualify for retired membership benefits, you must maintain your membership within six months of retiring.**

These benefits include:

- access to expert advice from headquarters;
- a 24-hour helpline offering free legal advice on non-employment matters;
- joining a vibrant network of retired members through area groups, coordinated by friendly area representatives;
- pensions guidance;
- assistance from the union's Benevolent Fund, a small charity independent from Prospect that supports those facing short-term, acute financial hardship. More details can be found at <https://members.prospect.org.uk/member-benefits/index#benevolent-fund>;
- access to additional Prospect membership perks, such as a free will-writing service offered through our legal partners;
- guidance on entitlement to state benefits.

PENSIONS ADVICE AND SUPPORT

Prospect will continue to advise on your current and future pension entitlements. We can represent you in any dispute with your former employer over your pension, for example dealing with the pension administrator such as MyCSP or with the social security appeal tribunal. Prospect expertise is based on our knowledge and dealings with more than 120 pension schemes in both the private and public sectors and our experience of dealing with personal cases taken out on behalf of members.

LIMITATIONS

Retired members are not entitled to work-related benefits, such as advice on employment rights, personal injury arising from work undertaken while in retired membership. If you decide to take up paid employment after you retire and want to be covered for these issues, you would need to revert to full Prospect membership.

Retired members do not have access to Prospect's death benefit scheme.

HOW MUCH DO I PAY?

As a retired member, irrespective of the age you retire, you pay a low monthly subscription rate (£3.94 in 2025) which can also be paid annually. If you are aged 55 or over, you can become a life member by paying a one-off lump sum which is ten times the annual rate.

If you retire under age 55, you can pay monthly or annually until you reach 55, when you can then buy life membership or just continue with monthly or annual payments.


